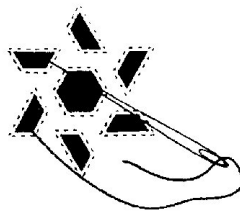

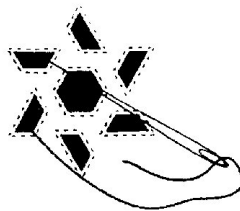

The Many Faces of Jerusalem

Quilters, quilt lovers and quilting teachers from all over the world are invited to gather in **Jerusalem** to take part in our Annual General Meeting celebrating the Israeli Quilters Association's (IQA) 20th Anniversary, on 2-5 July 2012. Full details of workshops and additional events will be posted on the website. A quilt exhibit entitled "The Many Faces of Jerusalem" will be held at this time.

The Exhibition will be held at two venues:

BYU, Mt of Olives

July 1st – Dec 31st, 2012

The Menachem Begin Heritage Center Museum

July 1st – July 16th, 2012

Jerusalem, the Capital of Israel, is holy to Jews, Christians and Moslems. Jerusalem is the "City of Nations". It is hard to find a more versatile city. People of many ethnic groups, nationalities and religions make Jerusalem home. Its history and architecture span thousands of years, with just as many stories and legends.

You are cordially invited to enter quilts in this exhibit. Create a quilt of Jerusalem as you know it or imagine it. Express your feelings, dreams and hopes. It will become Jerusalem as you love it.

Rules

The quilt must be an original work and not a reproduction of another work, created in the past 5 years.

Use of text or logos requires copyright permission.

Measurements

Width – minimum 100cm/ 39” maximum 150cm/ 59” +/- 5cm/2”

Length – minimum 100cm/ 39” maximum 150cm/ 59” +/- 5cm/2”

Techniques

You may use Traditional, Modern, or Art quilting, patchwork piecing, appliqué, fusing, photo transfer, commercial and hand dyed fabrics, embellishing with yarns, buttons, embroidery, etc.

The quilt may be hand and/or machine quilted. It must include 3 layers – top, batting and backing. The Backing should be of cotton fabric.

You may not frame the quilt with wood, plastic, metal, etc.

Label

Please sew a fabric label to the bottom left corner of the back of the quilt.

The label should include the following: the title of the quilt, measurements, year made, name and address of quilter, phone number and e-mail address.

Sleeves

Please attach 2 sleeves to the back of the quilt, one at the top edge and the other at the bottom edge. The sleeves should be 10cm/4” wide.

Please note – quilts with hanging loops will not be accepted.

Hanging rods will be supplied by the organizers.

Shipment

Ship your quilt in a box. The quilt should be wrapped in a plastic bag. Place one note with your name, address, phone number and email address inside the bag and another in the box.

Entry Fee

Payment should be made upon confirmation that your quilt/s have been accepted.

Fees are USD 50.00 or Euro 37.00 or CAD 52.00 or GBP 32.00 or any other currency equivalent to USD 50.00 – per quilt.

Return of Quilts

Quilts will be returned by regular Israel Postal Services parcel post. The cost is USD 35.00 or Euro 26.00 or CAD 36.00 or GBP 22.00 or any currency equivalent to USD 35.00 – per quilt.

Include this mail payment together with the entry fee.

Schedule

Please submit 2 photos of your quilt, one full view and one detail to include one of the corners.

Send the digital images by email to zklein75@yahoo.com no later than May 15, 2012.

Digital images should be saved as a JPEG file at 300dpi. The images should be saved at the highest resolution. Low megapixels and resolution setting can result in poor images that can eliminate a quilt.

Please include all the information as required in the entry form in the email.

Confirmation will be sent immediately upon receiving of mail. Confirmation of acceptance or rejection to the exhibition will be sent by May 22, 2012

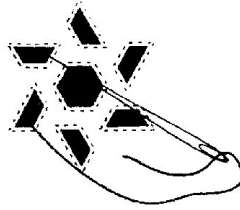
