Historic Cold Spring Village would like to **invite you** and your guild to participate in the ***Cape May Quilt and Fiber Show*** to be held on **Saturday, June 23rd and Sunday, June 24<sup>n</sup>** at the Museum Village. The weekend's events include a Viewer's Choice Quilt Show, sheep shearing, vintage quilt displays, spinning, wool dying, lace making, and a celebration of all the fibers used in the early 19<sup>th</sup> century. To encourage the public appreciation and participation in heritage crafts, the event has expanded in scope to reflect many fiber arts: embroidery, basket making, broom making, crocheting, felting, knitting and other fiber artisans all gathering and exchanging ideas and techniques.

The core of the event will be the **22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Quilt Show displayed in the Welcome Center**. The quilt show is judged by 'Viewer's Choice'. It is casual show, a great way share your talent with others.

**The 2012 Best in Show prize is \$250.00 in Country Store Gift Certificates.** Additional ribbons and prizes are awarded in individual categories.

A nominal fee of \$10.00 entitles you to

1. Unlimited number of registrations to enter the quilt show
2. One day's free admission to Historic Cold Spring Village
3. An invitation to the Awards Breakfast held at 9 am on Sunday morning at Historic Cold Spring Village.

A vendor's minimal fees are \$40.00 for one day or \$65.00 for the weekend, plus more if they need electricity. Should a vendor or participating quilting group wish to sell products please contact me regarding space available as locations are limited. Sale(s) of items on the grounds and the locations must be arranged in advance. **If demonstrations are done in the sales booth, please contact me to discuss the reduced fee structure.**

# CAPE MAY QUILT AND FIBER SHOW

## QUILT SHOW RULES

Any individual or group is eligible and encouraged to participate.

1. Each entry must have a label and the cover bag (a pillow case is ideal) labeled with your name, the quilts name & contact phone number clearly marked on the bag.
2. Large quilts, with lengths greater than 96 inches should bring a name labeled white sheet to put on the floor beneath the quilt to keep it clean. Please be aware the show is hung using clothespins and rope.
3. No quilts will be accepted without pre-registration. Contact Clare Juechter at (609) 898-2300 Ext 16 or [cjuechter@hcsv.org](mailto:cjuechter@hcsv.org) for a downloadable registration form [www.hcsv.org](http://www.hcsv.org) for more information. Registration closes on June 4, 2012.
4. Entry is to be three quilted layers (top, batting, and backing) with the exception of wearable art. Wearable art may be entered but not for judging.
5. Viewer Choice Categories are as follows:
  - △ BED QUILTS 140" minimum (L + W)
  - △ LARGE WALL HANGINGS OVER 80" (L + W)
  - △ SMALL & MINI QUILTS UNDER 80" (L + W)
6. All entries, once received by HCSV, will be retained for the duration of the show. **You may not pick up your quilt before the show is taken down.** They will be available for pick up on Sunday at 5:00 pm and throughout the following week.
7. **A registration fee of \$10.00 is charged for unlimited number entries.** Please make checks payable to Historic Cold Spring Village. All **paid participants** in the quilt show will **receive a free admission** for one day to the Village and are invited to **the awards breakfast** conducted at the Village on Sunday morning at 9:00 am.
8. Prizes are as follows: Best in Show is awarded \$250; First Place in a category is awarded \$100.00 and Second Place in a category is awarded \$50.00.
9. Your quilt, although carefully guarded, is entered into the Cape May Quilt Show at your own risk.
