

Trip Around the World in Eight Hours

We will be making a lap size (45 x 60) Trip around the world quilt. This is a great technique for recreating an old-time favorite. Traditionally made from individual squares this method, will be all strips. This makes it faster and easier than ever completing it in 8 hours

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards Focus Fabric (this will be part of the border)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard each 5 coordinating fabrics
- 1/2 yard fabric for 1st border if you want one
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard binding
- 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards backing

Tools Required:

- Sewing machine in good working order with 1/4" foot
- New 80/12 or 90/14 sewing machine needle
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- 6 1/2 x 24 ruler or June Taylor's shape cut ruler

- Cutting Mats
- Flannel back table cloths
- Neutral sewing thread (light gray, taupe or cream)
- Fabric scissors
- Sharp silk Pins
- Self-adhesive small labels
- All the usual sewing supplies
